Windsor Charter Academy (WCA) is an award-winning tuition-free public school serving Windsor, Greeley, Severance, Johnstown, Loveland, Fort Collins, and surrounding areas in northern Colorado. Windsor Charter Academy opened its doors in 2001 as a K-8 Core Knowledge School. In 2015, WCA expanded to a K-12 school by opening an early college high school.

Community

Windsor Charter Academy is authorized to operate by the Weld RE-4 School District. The Weld RE-4 School District includes Windsor, Severance, and parts of west Greeley. Windsor is located 50 miles north of Denver and is centrally located approximately 15 miles from Fort Collins, Loveland, and Greeley.

The Weld RE-4 School District is comprised of nine schools. Windsor Charter Academy has an additional three charter schools that operate in the district. Total district enrollment is estimated to be 8,228 students and increases each year with continued growth in the community. The Weld RE-4 School District is proud of the fact that all schools in the district are accredited by the Colorado Department of Education.

Windsor Charter Academy Early College High School

Windsor Charter Academy Early College High School provides students with four years of rigorous high school and college courses. Students have the opportunity to earn an Associate of Arts or an Associate of Science degree from Aims Community College without leaving our campus. Windsor Charter Academy's graduation requirements were developed based on entrance requirements of top colleges and universities and by analyzing strong academic curricula. Students must successfully complete a minimum of 26 credits in order to graduate from high school and 60 credits to graduate with an associate degree from Aims Community College. Students have eight classes per semester and are on a 90-minute block schedule.

Standardized Test Scores

- WCA Average SAT Score: 1106
- Colorado Average SAT Score: 989
- Highest Composite Score at WCA (2023): 1500

Grade Point Averages

Windsor Charter Academy's official transcripts reflect calculations for weighted and unweighted GPAs. Class rank is based on weighted GPA. The Class of 2023 averages were:
